Toxaway Views HOA Pool Rules & Regulations

Toxaway Views Pool season is Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. Pool Hours are from 8:30 a.m. - 8:30 p.m., weather permitting. To utilize the facility, Owners' dues must be in good standing.

I. GENERAL POOL RULES:

- A. Entrance and admission to the pool area implies agreement to all pool rules stated herein
- B. NO LIFE GUARD IS ON DUTY. Swim at your own risk.
- C. Anyone under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult or guardian at all times.
- D. Owners assume all responsibility for their guests and/or renters knowing and following the rules.
- E. Pool access gates are to remain closed and secure at all times.
- F. THERE IS NO TRASH SERVICE AT OR NEAR THE POOL. ALL trash, food items, diapers, etc., must be carried out by Owners, Renters, and their Guests and disposed of properly. Leave no trace!
- G. Food is permitted on the pool deck; however, eating and/or drinking is not permitted in the swimming pool.
- H. NO glassware or ceramics are permitted in the pool area.
- I. All food and beverage waste must be carried out and disposed of properly.
- J. Smoking is not allowed in pool or any part of the fenced-in pool area.
- K. No music is allowed, except for with the use of headphones, earbuds or other such devices that can be heard only by the owner so as not to disturb others.
- L. Private events and large group get-togethers are allowed only with prior Board approval.
- M. The HOA is **not** responsible for lost or stolen articles.

II. POOL GUEST POLICY:

- A. A "Guest" is anyone not living on-property at Toxaway Views.
- B. Each TV household may bring a maximum of 4 guests per visit. Individuals under 18 years of age are limited to bringing *one* guest per visit.
- C. All guests must be accompanied by a resident at all times. NOTE: visiting overnight "inresidence" guests (authorized overnight guests staying when Owner is not on property) are exempted from this requirement.
- D. All guests under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult or guardian at all times.
- E. Owners assume all responsibility for their guests or renters following the Pool and other rules.

III. SAFETY:

- A. No diving.
- B. Due to the size of the pool, multiple large flotation devices used simultaneously are not allowed.

- C. No running or boisterous, rough play, or loud disruptive noise is permitted in the pool area; no bikes, skates, scooters, or rollerblades, etc., are permitted inside the pool area.
- D. No furniture or equipment may be removed from the pool area or inappropriately used.
- E. The pump-room areas of the pool and waterfall are limited to Board-designated persons only.

IV. HYGIENE:

- A. It is required that all persons shower before entering the pool.
- B. No pets or animals are permitted in the fenced-in pool area with the exception of service animals.
- C. Use of pool should be avoided by any person having a skin infection, rash, nasal, eye or ear discharge, sore or inflamed eyes, communicable disease, excessive sunburn, open sores or infants and toddlers without swim diapers*.
- D. Spitting, spouting water, blowing the nose and similar unhygienic actions are prohibited in the pool.
- E. Chewing gum is prohibited in the pool.
- F. Swimmers, including infants and toddlers*, must wear appropriate bathing attire. No cut-offs, street clothes, thongs, etc., are allowed.
 - 1. *Swim Diapers: All children who are not potty-trained will be required to wear vinyl pants and Swim Diapers under their swimsuit.
 - 2. Cloth diapers and disposable diapers ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL.
 - 3. Do not dispose of diapers in the pool area or surrounding area. All trash must be carried out and disposed of properly.
- G. If a fecal accident occurs, Owner will be assessed the full cost for the pool tech services and chemicals required to treat the pool. In the case of fecal/vomit matter in the swimming pool, the pool will close following policies outlined by the State of North Carolina Health Department for solid fecal, vomit, and/or loose fecal matter. Maximum closing will be necessary to correct the problem.

V. VIOLATIONS:

- A. TV HOA reserves the right to end any playing or behavior deemed unsafe or considered an annoyance to others.
- B. TV HOA also has the right to ask a person whom they consider unruly or intoxicated to leave the premises.
- C. Violation of these rules by residents or guests may result in fines, suspension of pool privileges, and/or imposition of other legal sanctions.
- D. It is each TV resident's responsibility to comply with the pool rules.
- E. Violation of these rules by residents or guests may result in fines, suspension of pool privileges, and/or imposition of other legal sanctions. TV Board of Directors reserves the right to terminate pool access for vandalism, violations, after-hours entry, or outstanding homeowner dues.
- F. The gas BBQ grill located at the pool deck is provided for the enjoyment of our residents. The gas supply has a shutoff valve located in front where the gas line connects. Those choosing to us the grill shall, following its use, fully heat/clean, shutoff gas, and after cool-down, cover it.
